### *Decking*

*Decking is the part of the Bedskirt that sits on the top of the box-spring and generally has the same dimensions as the box-spring. Decking is rarely seen since the mattress sits on top of the Bedskirt decking.*

### *Matelasses*

*Matelasses are one side of fabric, rounded at the bottom corners, and finished with either piping or bias around the outer edge. Matelasses have an unstructured 15" drop and should go with a Bedskirt. These Matelasses are unlined and does not have a pillow tuck,*

### *Drop*

*Bedskirt Drop: The Bedskirt drop is determined by measuring from the top of the box spring to where you want the skirt to end. This measurement is important to the overall look of the Bedskirt. If you want the Bedskirt to pool or drape on the floor, add 1 inch to the drop. Our Collections offer Bedskirts in 14" and 18" lengths.*

*Fitted Coverlet Drop: Similar to the Bedskirt, the Fitted Coverlet Drop is the measurement from the top of your mattress to where you want the Coverlet to end.*

This makes it easy for you to coordinate your entire room shape with window treatments and upholstery. All fabrics are stocked by the manufacturer for fast delivery, and each is inspected for quality and durability before it is incorporated into any bedding Collection.*

*We do not assume responsibility for fabric dye lot changes. Your order will be made in its entirety from the same dye lot, but subsequent orders are not guaranteed to match. If you want to make matching drapes or slipcovers then order all needed yardage at the same time.*

### *Fabric Throws*

*Fabric Throws are constructed of one width of fabric on each side and are finished with a decorative trim, braid, or fringe.*

*Fitted Coverlets are lined and include gussets at the bottom corners. Coverlets are meant to be used with a Bedskirt. They do not have a pillow tuck. Fitted Coverlets feature piping at the bed perimeter (around the top of the mattress) and are offered with 15" and 19" drops.*

### *Pillows*

*Each decorative Pillow is finished with a hidden zipper closure and is individually filled with a poly fill pillow form.*

## Product Care Instructions

Meticulous care is taken to create each of our luxurious products. To enjoy your Elk Meadows Enterprises selection for many years to come, we recommend dry cleaning for all products. Sheet Sets should be laundered in lukewarm or cold water, medium heat to dry. Make sure you remove fills before cleaning.

## Quilted throw Coverlets

Quilted Throw Coverlets are lined, have a 10-oz. poly fill filling, and are finished with fabric piping or jumbo welt around 3 sides. They are meant to be used in conjunction with a Bedskirt and do not have a pillow tuck.

## Throw Coverlets

Throw Coverlets are one side of fabric, rounded at the bottom corners, and finished with either piping or bias around the outer edge. Throw Coverlets have an unstructured 15" drop and are meant go with a Bedskirt. Throws Coverlets are unlined and have no pillow tuck.

## Glossary of a few Design Terms

**Bullion** - Decorative fringe that is generally 2" to 4" in length

**Flange** - ½" to 2" of fabric that extends beyond the pocket of the Pillow or Sham

**Matelasse** - A fabric with the appearance of quilting, resembling a bubbly pattern

**Railroaded** - Generally, fabric patterns run off the fabric bolt in a continuous flow (vertically). A fabric pattern is considered "Railroaded" when the pattern runs horizontally on the bolt, from selvage to selvage

**Jumbo Welt** - ¾" round cording which is usually covered with fabric and used as decorative trim or finish

**Welt** - ¼" round cording which is usually covered with fabric and used as decorative trim or finish
